(‘Longlist’ indicating things that might be looked at)

- Task and Finish Group to research cost and recommend renewable energy efficiency and waste reduction/recycling policy/activities (could be TTC or entire Parish)
- Encourage “green” businesses to come to Tavistock
- Encourage traders to use “green” packaging/supplies (work with BID)
- Prioritise “local” producers when booking for events etc.
- When responding to planning applications encourage developers to use sustainable energy efficient buildings methods/products
- By the end of this Council to have installed a minimum of four electric car charging points in Market Road
- To provide secure cycle racks on TTC land and encourage on new developments
- Tree planting scheme
- Install drinking water fountains/facility to refill water bottles on TTC land
- Charge for parking on TTC land e.g. triangle at bottom of Down Road
