49. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The following Personal Declarations of Interest were made;

- Councillor Mrs A Johnson declared a Personal Interest in the Town Planning Issue on the Agenda – Parking at Grenville Drive, by virtue of a close family member owning a property in the area. Councillor Mrs Johnson spoke as a member of the public, then left the Meeting whilst the item was fully considered;
- Councillor A Hutton (Chairman) declared a Pecuniary Interest in Planning Application 2138/18/FUL – Land adjacent to Breckland, Down Road, Tavistock PL19 9AG by virtue of owning the adjacent property. Councillor Hutton left the Meeting during the consideration of this Application, and the Vice Chairman took over the chairmanship for this Application;

- Councillor P Squire declared Personal Interests in Planning Applications 1921/18/TCA (15 Waters Edge, Parkwood Road, Tavistock PL19 0AR) and 1998/18/PAD (Pixon Lane Trading Centre, Pixon Lane, Tavistock PL19 8DH) by virtue of a friendship with both applicants, and took no part in the consideration of either of these Applications;
- Councillor Mrs M Ewings declared a Personal Interest in Planning Application 2095/18/TPO (Dennathorne, Down Road, Tavistock PL19 9AG) later in the Meeting, by virtue of having a business relationship with the applicant and took no part in the consideration of this Application

51. TOWN PLANNING ISSUES

Councillor Mrs M Ewings arrived during the consideration of this item.

a) Parking at Grenville Drive, Tavistock – this matter had been brought to the Committee at the request of Councillor Ms L Crawford, who had provided a briefing note (Appendix 2)

Councillor Mrs A Johnson declared a Personal Interest, withdrew from the Meeting, and then made a short statement as a member of the public prior to leaving the room during consideration of the item. A member of the public confirmed they had personally witnessed the inability of a fire engine to reach a property in Grenville Drive, due to the poor parking of vehicles in the road and that on many occasions refuse lorries had been unable to reach properties further up the road.

The member of the public also confirmed that the emergency lane beside Grenville Drive was not wide enough to allow the passage of emergency vehicles through it, so was not in their opinion an option.

A debate then ensued which made particular reference to;

- sympathy for residents in Grenville Drive and Westbridge Cottages with regard the problems they faced with parking near or exiting/accessing their properties;
- safety issues involved, in particular the accessibility for emergency vehicles. The safety of residents being of paramount importance;

- the erosion of parking availability which had not been addressed historically both in this location and elsewhere;
- the dangers pedestrians faced with cars being partially parked on pavements;

A proposal was made and it was;

RECOMMENDED THAT Tavistock Town Council uphold its previous decision, which was to 'support' the Traffic Order.

Members were referred to Minute No. 300(a) from 23rd January, 2018 which encouraged any Councillors who wished to do so, to liaise with those Tavistock South West Members who were not otherwise affected by an interest to put together suggestions to the Highway Authority for improvements which could be made in the identified area, in order that same could be considered.
