The Survey

We will monitor the responses as we receive them Our goal 30% completion rate of eligible responders

Online or on paper – opportunity for anyone over 16 to participate

A reminder, the more people who respond, the more impactful will be the evidence gathered to be put forward for recommendations of the joint local plans.

We will monitor the response rate over the survey period which will be around 8 weeks -2 May 2022. If things are not going so well with response rates or a particular demographic, we can do some focused targeting from the information given by DCT, who are collecting and collating the data, to ensure a good response.

Survey delivery

Will be hand delivered to 6100 households to save postage expense.
