# PANNIER MARKET

## 1. General Update

- a) Capacity levels as we edge towards Christmas have been good, with the exception of one of the Mondays, this was because logistically it fell the wrong side of a Miss Ivy event, so those that would usually stay over had to pack down, nonetheless other additional days have been popular with footfall so far being positive.
- b) Dickensian Evening was a success from a Pannier Market perspective, footfall was extremely good with many traders reporting a great days trading. Also, the Pannier Market won a best dressed award, there were so many great costumes to choose from the Mayor gave the award to the market traders as a collective.
- c) On Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> December we have our 'Christmas at Tavistock Pannier Market' event, this includes the main Pannier Market being open, Butchers' Hall Christmas Market and an array of Christmas festivity on Bedford Square, this includes, a giant snow globe, roasted chestnuts courtesy of the Robey Trust, live music, food and drink and other Christmas related crafts, we also have a Santa's grotto within the Pannier Market and the chance to win a hamper with Tavistock Pannier Markets Golden Ticket.

# 2. Bedford Square/Events

- a) Bedford Square has had the usual mix of regular traders plus some new additions, this has been despite some inclement weather conditions. Overall Bedford Square has faired well this period, even with the scaffolding interruptions and the trees of light. The scaffolding is in the process of being removed, with the finished date scheduled for 23<sup>rd</sup> December,
- b)Once we have Christmas out of the way, we will look in January at plans and initiatives for 2024, we will continue to work in partnership with Tavistock Farmer's Market on delivering all of the operational aspects of this regular booking.

#### 6. December/Christmas Opening Times

During December we have Miss Ivy's Christmas Festival in the Pannier Market on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> and on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> we have our own Christmas market, as usual, we are also open for the last two Monday's before Christmas, this year's dates are Monday 11<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> respectively, this means we will open everyday from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December up to and including Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup>. We will be closed this year on Christmas Eve as it falls on a Sunday.

Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> December (Christmas Eve) – Closed Monday 25<sup>th</sup> December (Christmas day) – Closed Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> December (Boxing Day) – Closed Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> December – Closed Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> December – Open Friday 29<sup>th</sup> December – Open Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> December – Open Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> December – Closed New Year's Day – Closed Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2024 – Normal trading commences.
