General Update

- Dickensian Evening this year is full to capacity this year with a waiting list of reserve traders.
- The lock-up unit that formerly was The Honey Pot has now been allocated as a five day pitch to Tarsia Designs who are a bespoke joinery business.
- The first consultation meeting has taken place relating to the Public Realm works to the market perimeter, there was a disappointing showing from traders; hopefully the second consultation on the 12th December will be better attended. The contractor gave a brief presentation on how the works would be delivered with a completion date of April 26th 2019, and answered questions.

Please Note: Following the Pannier Market works, and the re-configuration of tables, full capacity is now 177 tables, rather than 184 tables as previously (96% of previous availability). This will therefore impact on the amount of income which is able to be derived from day traders, pro rata.

All five day pitches apart from one have now been let; we have seen a steady rise in takings over the past three weeks and were running at 99% occupancy for week ending 02/12/18. We will endeavour to keep up with recent figures throughout December which will see a more healthy reflection on previous years.
