I also attended a meeting with Devon County Council, BID, and the Chamber regarding the County councils proposed plans for Parking meters, finally they showed us their plan.

Outside of Tavistock I have been involved through advisory groups with the proposed boundary changes and Governance reviews with Okehampton and the Hamlets as well as Sydenham Damerel, these are progressing, and the consultation process has only recently finished 1st December.
