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Properties:

- **Guildhall** Installation of leak detection system in Guildhall cancelled due to imminent Permission to Start for Guildhall project with significant mechanical and electrical alterations planned for 2019. Smart meters for gas installed.
- Repair of the bay window in the Council Chamber Westcountry Stonemasons Ltd has been contracted to undertake the a full repair including scaffolding, stone repair, lead work, repointing and reinstatement for the sum of £8,260 ex VAT. Discussions on-going with WDBC and measured survey commissioned at their request as part of the LBC requirements.
