## Properties:

- Repair of the bay window in the Council Chamber Westcountry Stonemasons Ltd has been contracted to undertake the a full repair including scaffolding, stone repair, lead work, repointing and reinstatement for the sum of £8,260 ex VAT. A measured survey has been completed and LBC has been submitted to WDBC, awaiting decision.
- Tower Room, Abbey Chapel Minor roof repairs scheduled for completion by 30.11.18.
- Pannier Market Public Realm Contract Pre-start meeting planned for 19<sup>th</sup> Oct with Cormac. Work is due to start in Feb 2019, due for completion by beginning of May 2019.
- LEV testing at Molly Owen Centre has been done, remedial works pending to install additional pressure gauges to be completed by end of Nov 18.
- Duke Street contract Final maintenance period handover inspection arranged for 18<sup>th</sup> Oct.
- Specification being written to rectify damp issues in basement of 9 Duke Street. Rear of 14 Duke Street loose cables re-fixed and front door repaired.
- Damp issues being investigated in 2 Market Rd.
- Fire alarm inspections undertaken in Duke Street, Butchers Hall, Pannier market and Town Hall. Inspection of lightening conductors scheduled for Nov 18.

## Maintenance:

- Play Parks Regular (fortnightly) inspections on-going. Repairs to ramps within the skate park complete.
- Potholes Significant repairs to surface of Market Road completed 05.10.18.
- Benches on-going repairs and maintenance with one new bench installed in Parkwood Rd.
- Agreement reached regarding on-going goodwill maintenance of churchyard; e.g. grass cutting and hedge shaping.
- Properties clearance works to rainwater goods on Guildhall and Town Hall with minor roofing repairs to Butchers Hall/Pannier Market. Prices being sought to install UV film on low level skylights in Pannier Market.
- Remedial works carried out to street lighting in Meadows on 5<sup>th</sup> Oct.
- Two smart meters installed in Guildhall and one in MOC.
- Contract signed for maintenance of glass doors for Butchers Hall and Pannier Market.

# Land Management:

- WDBC Maintenance Contract on-going
- One final cut of all areas scheduled for Oct 18. Market Rd, Abbey Bridge, Abbey Walk and Dolvin Rd wall weeded and foliage removed/drains cleared. Regular leaf clearing carried out. Spraying undertaken of all areas.
- Pest Control Contract re-signed for monthly pest control service in Pannier Market, Guildhall, MOC and Meadows.

- Hanging baskets removed in advance of Goose Fair.
- RHS It's Your Neighbourhood The Pop-up Allotment, Cottage Garden, Rose Walk, Sensory Garden, Tidy Tavy and Green Burial Area at Plymouth Road Cemetery all rated as outstanding, the highest commendation.
