

Pannier Market Report August/September 2020

We are now currently operating at four days a week with the opening days being, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays 9am–4pm, we will be shortly undertaking the next review in conjunction with the trader Covid-19 consultative group, this will be to ascertain how we move into the winter period whilst reviewing all aspects of the current configurations and measures.

We are now in the fourth week of holding a weekly Tuesday Antique Market in Butchers' Hall, this has proved very popular and is operating at the current capacity on a weekly basis, with further interest from a host of Antique traders across the market activities.

In relation to the Covid restrictions in place, we have now slightly relaxed some of the measures, previously we operated a one entrance, one exit system, we have now opened up all entrances with sanitiser units and signage on every door, however we have still maintained the current lay out so that social distancing remains the number one priority for customer confidence and public and trader safety. We have also opened up additional entry points into Bob's Café.

We have also now relaxed the system for the market toilets, they are now only manned at busy times, with relevant signage for responsible public use in place, all Coronavirus cleaning regulations remain in place with regular checks/cleans being undertaken, this has eased staffing capacity pressures.

Tavistock Music & Video has decided to call it a day after over 25 years in the Pannier Market, the owner has decided to retire, their last trading day will Saturday 19th September.

Interviews are being held on Wednesday 9th September for the soon to be vacant Markets & Event Assistant post.
