PANNIER MARKET

1. General Update

- a) VE Day was a success from an operational perspective, with activity being in full swing in the Guildhall carpark and on Bedford Square. Celebrations were then extended to the beacon lighting at The Pimple, where visitors were offered refreshments courtesy of TTC. Spectators witnessed an ex-evacuee light the Lamp of Peace with an 8-year-old competition winner, followed by the lighting of the Beacon itself.
- b) We were recently visited by a Councillor from Teignbridge District Council, who expressed interest in various aspects of how Tavistock Town Council manages its commercial properties, as well as the delivery of our Market operations. The visitor was welcomed by the Mayor, followed by meetings with the Assistant to the Town Clerk and the Market Reeve. We have also since been approached by representatives from St Ives Town Council, who are keen to learn more about the operation of our Market activities. Their visit is scheduled for June.
- c) One of our Lock-up unit has now become available, with the occupier not renewing their Licence, so we are currently looking for a suitable replacement. The trader in question is however not leaving altogether, they are moving to a vacant five-day pitch elsewhere in the Market, as they feel operating their business from tables from a new location would be more beneficial to their business model.
- d) With the fairer weather remaining consistent at present, we have been looking at some redecoration work in and around the Market Complex, as well as the signage previously reported on. We will look to repaint the green poles along the market colonnade and also the surrounding Market gates, this work will be done internally across the Summer period.
