# TAVISTOCK TOWN COUNCIL TOWN HALL & BUTCHERS' HALL REPORT SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER 2025 DATE OF REPORT 27/10/25

#### **Town Hall**

## 1. General Update

- a) September saw an increase in bar led functions, with two wedding receptions and one evening party taking place during this period. Feedback from all three events was very positive, and with guest numbers of 100+ for each event bar sales were also good.
- b) Tavistock Town Hall served as the reception venue for guests attending the Tavistock Town Council Civic Service at St Eustachius Church on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> October, with light refreshments being provided for attendees.
- c) The next Town Hall bar audit is due to take place on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> October.
- d) The Town Hall continues to host a number of regular weekly hirers including Full of Life (Monday and Friday), Line Dancing (Tuesday), Vocal Harem (Tuesday), Dartmoor Dancers (Wednesday), Zumba (Thursday), as well as U3A (monthly).
- e) The Town Hall will be welcoming the annual hirer 'Tavistock Musical Theatre Company' back from 3<sup>rd</sup> November 9<sup>th</sup> November for their performance of Chitty Chitty Bang Bang.
- f) A review is being undertaken to identify training courses which would be appropriate for the Market & Events staff to complete to further enhance their skills.
- g) Bookings have continued to come in for exhibitors at the Town Hall & Butchers Hall Wedding Fair which is due to take place on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2026 which we aim to grow from its inaugural event in 2025.

#### **Butchers' Hall**

- a) September and October saw the return of a number of annual Butchers Hall hirers, including the Tavistock Group of Artists Exhibition, Westcountry Potters Association Market, and the West Devon Community and Voluntary Services event. We also have a new regular Butchers Hall hirer 'The Artisan Crafters' who held a market during this time. Feedback across all external hirers was good, with footfall being in line with expectations for these events.
- b) The feedback from traders who exhibited in Butchers Hall during the Goose Fair event was very positive, with good footfall being reported through the majority of the event, however it was reported by traders that the levels of footfall tapered off significantly towards the end of

- the Goose Fair market. The timings for this market will be reviewed ahead of the 2026 event.
- c) Dates for the themed markets for 2026 have been sent out to all regular traders who attend the Butchers Hall markets.

Dickensian Market – 4<sup>th</sup> December (subject to confirmation)
Christmas Markets – 12<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> December
