PANNIER MARKET

1. General Update

- a) Members will recall that, in the previous reporting period, the formerly vacant unit (Lock-Up 1) was being used as a pop-up outlet by Odds & Sudds until Christmas. I am pleased to report that they will continue trading beyond the Christmas period, having now signed a formal lease. In a separate development, Devon Chocolates has decided to retire and will cease trading after the Christmas period. They have provided valued service within the Pannier Market for the past ten years, and we wish them well in their retirement. They have, however, indicated that they may wish to attend on an ad-hoc basis from time to time.
- b) There has been a positive uptake to our additional festive markets, in particular the extra Sunday's and Monday's, which are almost at full capacity, and furthermore, as from Tuesday 09th December, the Pannier Market will open every day through to and including Christmas Eve.
- c) Despite some challenging conditions, Dickensian Evening went well from the perspective of the Pannier Market, with footfall not quite as good as usual, but was certainly not quiet considering the huge early downpour of rain. Once again this year there was a great effort from the traders with their costumes, and overall there was a really good atmosphere.
- d) Looking forward into 2026, things are looking positive with a healthy volume of trader applications being submitted, and although it is still challenging times in the current economic climate, its good to see that businesses are choosing the Pannier Market as a viable option to continue or start a business venture.

Bedford Square/Events

- a) November and December has proved to be a fairly challenging time on Bedford Square, with difficult weather conditions mixed with the older marquees and equipment deteriorating quite badly in recent times. A briefing note has been submitted with a proposal to purchase some new ones.

- b) There will be plenty of activity on the Square from now until Christmas, with an array of regular traders, and some selling predominantly Christmas related wares.

Farmers Market Dates 2025

There is now only one Farmers Market left in 2025. Which is Saturday 13th December. The dates for 2026 will be presented during the next round of reports.
