# BRIEFING NOTE CORONAVIRUS HEALTH EMERGENCY SOCIAL FUND & RELATED MATTERS

### 1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The Committee will recall that, at the last Meeting of Council, the foregoing grant scheme was established to provide support for eligible organisations assisting with the pandemic community relief effort.

- 1.3 The purpose of this briefing note is therefore to provide opportunity to the Committee to:
  - a) Note awards made to date (please refer to the 'Delegated Decision Schedule' for awards made as listed elsewhere on this agenda);
  - b) Consider whether it wishes to endorse the continuation of
    - the operation of the Scheme under the current delegation<sup>1</sup>
    - ii. emergency delegation<sup>2</sup> arrangements in the event that urgent decisions are required at short notice which cannot practicably be secured through the normal meeting process.

## 2.SUMMARY

- 2.1 The Scheme has been effective in providing support to organisations supporting the local relief effort in a timely manner (usually turning them around within 72hrs), as has the wider emergency delegation.
- 2.2 To enable the Scheme to continue to operate in a timely manner it is recommended that it continue to be administered on the

same basis of operation as at present - subject to applications being brought before the Budget and Policy Committee for determination in the event there is a lack of unanimous agreement as to outcome between the existing parties to decisions.

2.3 It is also proposed that the current broader emergency delegation be retained specifically insofar as urgent decisions may still need to be made at very short notice only.
