1. ELECTION OF MAYOR

Nominations were invited for the election of Mayor of Tavistock Town Council for the 2016-17 Civic Year.

A nomination was received in respect of Councillor Mrs M Ewings (proposed by Councillor C Rogers and seconded by Councillor A Venning).

There being no other nomination it was:

RESOLVED THAT Councillor Mrs M Ewings be elected Mayor of Tavistock Town Council for the 2016-17 Civic Year.
